The Professional profiles of the Agri-Food sector: an opportunity for integration of migrants

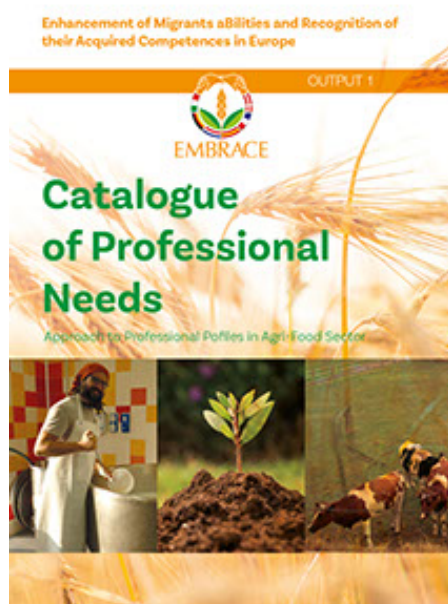

Catalogue of Professional Needs



Approach to Professional Profiles in Agri-Food Sector

The Catalogue is the result of the cooperation between 8 European partners, involved in Embrace Project. The implementation of the catalogue is based on the outcomes from two project activities: first, the comparison and mapping of the methodologies used in the different countries for the identification and validation of migrants' non-formal and informal competences and skills; second, the identification of case studies of main job-profiles needed and the demands of the international labour market, in the different contexts involved. The professional profiles analysed are related to the agri-food sector (cultivation, farming and processing of raw materials) and they were chosen within existing professional profiles in the national and regional repertoires of partner countries.

Upcoming activities:

In the upcoming months, the project partners will work on:

- developing of methodological guidelines to recognize and validate competences of citizens coming from third countries, tested on 33 case studies within the agri-food sector and transferable to other contexts;
- creating of a new tool to validate skills adequate to the target;
- organizing an international Embrace conference in Turin, Italy in June 2019

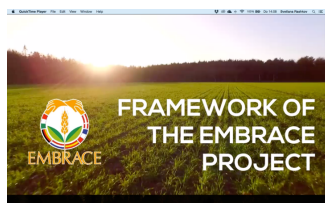

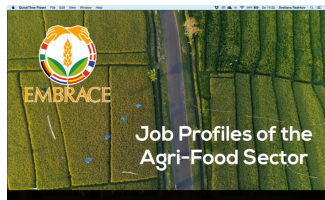
