EMBRACE TOOLKIT IS READY FOR USE!

After almost three years of dedicated work the eight partners of the Embrace project from Italy, Spain, France, Denmark, The Netherlands and Germany, are proud to present the innovative methodology developed to identify, document and validate non-formal and informal competences acquired anywhere by migrants (in their origin country or in another EU state) in order to improve their opportunities and access into the European labour market, especially in the agri-food sector. The project target group consists of migrants coming from non-EU countries recently arrived in our continent, currently unemployed, with or without a formal education certification, with or without a former job in their country of origin, or in another EU country.

The project outputs include:

- Catalogue of professional needs
- Guidelines on the Embrace Skills Identification and Validation Process
- Toolkit containing tools for the identification and validation process

Methodology
The tools description section is based on the 5W rule: WHAT: what is the described tool about, WHY: what is the tool used for, WHO: who uses it, that is to say who is in charge of the completion, WHEN: in which phase of the process is the tool used, WHERE: in which context is the tool used and accurately describes each step of the process.
